## Angels & Demons Angels

### What is an angel?

- An eternal spirit created by God; it is a celestial or supernatural being that acts as an intermediary between God and humans.
- The word 'angel' comes from the Greek word
   'aggelus' which means 'messenger'.
- Angels have no physical bodies nor a specific gender, but are often represented in bodily form with wings.
- They exist in heaven and the spirit realm and can sometimes be seen or heard by people, including in their dreams.



## Angels & Demons Angels

### What is a Guardian Angel?

- A guardian angel is a spirit assigned by God that protects and looks after a specific person throughout their life.
- Many contend that each person has a guardian angel and its invisible force shields them from serious harm, including malevolent (evil) spirits.



## Angels & Demons Angels

### What is a Fallen Angel?

- A fallen angel is an angel that has
  disobeyed God, is banished from heaven,
  and punished to become a demon
   a lesser, evil spirit.
- Since all spirits are eternal, they cannot be destroyed; thusly, a demon will continue to exist in hell, but may still sometimes intervene in the physical world.



### Archangels

- An archangel is a higher order angel.
- The word archangel comes from a Greek word 'archangelos' meaning 'chief' or 'ruling' angel; thusly, an archangel is a 'chief messenger'.
- In a way, archangels are in charge of heaven's armies (of angels) to battle against demons, evil, and the devil (Satan the leader of demons).
- Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael are three commonly referenced archangels in several religions.

# Angels & Demons Demons What is a demon?

- A preternatural malevolent spirit or entity.
- The ancient Greek word  $\delta \alpha i \mu \omega \nu$  daim on denotes a spirit or divine power.
- Demons are recognized as real in many cultures and major religions. In Christianity, they are referred to as fallen angels.
- Although there are many distinct demons, Satan (Lucifer, the fallen angel) is the principal one referred to by Christians and Jews and the term devil is often use to describe either him or the personification of evil.





#### Demons

- A few important/key characteristics of demons, more precisely referred to as inhuman demonical spirits include intelligence and deceit. For example, they can know the intimate details and secrets of people and use it against them.
- Since these entities are immortal and have existed since the beginning of time, the knowledge, power, and wisdom they have amassed is formidable.
- They also hold **metaphysical abilities** such as **telepathy** [e.g., infusing thoughts or images into people's minds] and **teleportation** (of objects).
- Another such metaphysical ability consists of creating apports which
  consist of materialized substances that are specifically used for
  intimidation purposes or to cause harm to people. Examples include
  blood, urine, excrement, insects (such as flies), stones, and even animals.

#### Demons

- Such materials created from a seemingly impossible phenomena have been collected by psychic investigators and analyzed in labs, most of which contain elements such as minerals and proteins found in nature.
- As quickly as these apports can materialized, they can also dematerialize (disappear).
- Demoniacal activity can occur in 3 stages:
  - 1. Infestation to make its presence known and instill fear
  - 2. Oppression to intimidate & terrorize with the objective of breaking down peoples' will
  - 3. Possession to take control of the afflicted's body, mind, and will to ultimately cause calamity including suicide, death, and harm to others
